

## TMR is the most traded stock on the Bratislava Stock Exchange

**DEMÄNOVSKÁ DOLINA (June 28, 2011) – In 2010 the trades of TMR stock exceeded 70% of the total trade volume on BSE. The general director of the BSE, Mária Hurajová, awarded Bohuš Hlavatý, the chairman of the TMR Board, with the prestigious award for the most traded stock on BSE.**

Tatry mountain resorts present so called New Tatras´ Era. They invest huge capital expenditures into the existing mountain resorts in the High Tatras and the Low Tatras, improve quality and competition in Slovakia, as well as in Central Europe.

The leading position of TMR was recently confirmed on the stock market. On June 23, 2011 the general director of the BSE, Mária Hurajová, awarded Bohuš Hlavatý, the chairman of the TMR Board with a **prestigious award for the most traded stock on BSE in 2010.**

According to the stock trade volume on BSE, The TMR stock is the most traded stock in 2010. The total amount of trades is 162,302,129 EUR, which is more than 70% of the total trade volume on BSE in 2010. The average daily volume of traded stock amounts to 646,622 EUR. Total number of traded days is 251 for the year.

*“The interest in our stock confirms that our strategy is correct. I appreciate the award and I am proud on behalf of the whole TMR team”, said chairman of the TMR Board, Bohuš Hlavatý.*

In May TMR trades represented 57.7% of the total trade volume on BSE. As of June 28, 2011, based on the current stock price of 42.55 EUR, **the total annual capital gain amounts to 11.1%** (9.2% stock return plus a dividend yield of 1.9%).

J&T Banka is the market maker for TMR stock and has significantly influenced the excellent result.

TMR’s portfolio includes the resort Jasná Nízke Tatry and the hotel Grand Jasná, Tri studničky and Ski Záhradky hotels in the Low Tatras. In the High Tatras TMR owns and operates the resorts Tatranská Lomnica, Grandhotel Starý Smokovec and Liptovská Teplička as well as hotels Grandhotel Praha Tatranská Lomnica and Grandhotel Starý Smokovec and Hotel FIS Štrbské pleso. The TMR Company has already invested over EUR 70 million of capital expenditures into these resorts, and plans to spend additional EUR 65 million on the projects, which are to be focused on increasing the standard and visit rate of our mountains for the following years. The last TMR acquisition is the Aquapark Tatalandia, the biggest Slovak thermal aquapark, which offers except for water entertainment also the entertainment in Wild West style in Western City as well as accomodation in bungalows and apartments of Holiday Village Tatalandia.
