

## Revitalisation of the cross timber in Tatranská Lomnica.

**DEMANOVSKA DOLINA (4th May 2011) – The largest investor in the Tatras in the cooperation with ŠL TANAP realizes the amenity outplanting, revitalisation of the cross timber in Tatranská Lomnica. Up to 5000 trees will be outplanted in the surrounding of ski resort Vysoké Tatry – Tatranská Lomnica.**

The company Tatry mountain resorts, a.s. invested into the new infrastructure of the resorts in the Low and in the High Tatras before lately finished winter season more than 25 mil. EUR. Thanks to the investments, other kilometres of artificial snowed rails and new cableways, the resorts reported, despite of the lack of natural snow, a very good winter season.

The snow disappeared from most of the ski slopes and the surrounding of the resorts and the TMR company currently realizes the revitalisation of the cross timber in to cooperation with ŠL TANAP. On the area of approx. 1 ha there is the amenity outplanting. Last week the company applied the hydro seeding process. The area of 8 570 m<sup>2</sup> is grass covered.

*“I participated on the afforestation actively. The tourists visit the Tatras because of attractions in the beautiful Tatras scenario mainly, accordingly to that, I am glad, that I also participated on the amenity outplanting.”* said Dušan Slávkovský, director of the mountain resort.

Work on the afforestation the area above the accumulation tank Tatranská Lomnica will be completed this week and the location will be added up to 5,000 new trees.
