

TRIO opens summer season in Tatralandia

DEMĀNOVSKÁ DOLINA (June 7, 2011) – the first and the biggest Slovak aquapark has come up with an absolute novelty. Toboggan Trio – a family toboggan, where you ride in front of each other. The launch of the toboggan is planned on the Sunday, June 12, 2011 at 3 p.m. It will be brought into operation symbolically by three families...

Acquiring Tatralandia is a significant step in fulfilling the strategy of TMR to build a **year-round tourist destination**. During 8 years of its operation, Tatralandia has come each year with a new attraction for its guests.. It is **the largest aquapark in Slovakia** and one of the largest aquaparks in Central Europe. It is not only about the swimming pools and toboggans, but it also offers many amusing activities for the whole family. Visitors can enjoy the entertainment and accommodation in beautiful mountain scenery.

The main **novelty of this summer season is the family rafting toboggan Trio**. The toboggan offers triple experience of the ride. The premier ride on the 3-raft in front of each other is planned on Saturday (June 11). On the same day all the summer attractions will be brought into operation as well as the accommodation packages including attractive SLOVAKIA AQUA FUN PAS launch the sale. By purchasing this combined summer product the visitors can enjoy **5 Slovak resorts including Tatralandia, 2200 m of toboggans** and swings, **26 swimming pools, cableways** in the High and the Low Tatras; all together **500 attractions** for one special price.

The launch of the original toboggan Trio will take place on Sunday June 12, 2011. The animation programme, games and competitions are prepared for the day. The guest host of the programme will be **Andrej Bičan**. The launch of the **Trio toboggan** will be symbolic. It starts at **3 p.m.** and **three families** will bring it into operation using water from Tatralandia. A special programme in **Western City** is prepared for the visitors for **only 1 euro**.

The unique offer of toboggans in Tatralandia also includes a rafting U-ramp or a rafting funnel toboggan Tornado – only one of a kind in Eastern Europe. Tatralandia promises higher comfort during this summer. At the disposal of the guests are 4000 of deck chairs. The chip system will assure better **freedom of movement during the stay**. The visitors will not be bothered by carrying the cash. On the contrary, they can postpone payment with cash and credit card until the check out time, because at the entrance they receive an electronic chip, which will notice all the consumption or other additional purchases. The visitors will pay when they leave the aquapark. In order to offer higher comfort for the visitors Tatralandia announces: “Don’t you like waiting in lines for the toboggan? Thanks to an **Express Pass** you can be the first on the 2 km long toboggan trail!”

Directly at the premises of the aquapark, the so called **Western City** can be found. This summer holiday, the entrance is for free. The visitors can see the Wild West show including many actor and stunt performances in the city. Stylish restaurants, bars and typical western stores are not missing. The visitors can also enjoy attractions such as archery, tomahawk throwing, gold washing, riding on a horse or an electric bull. The main attraction is a natural open air theatre for 3000 visitors, where there are many different performances during the day.

Tatry mountain resorts, a.s. is the largest subject in tourism segment in the Slovak Republic. It owns and operates attractive ski resorts and hotels in the Low and in the High Tatras. TMR’s portfolio includes the resort Jasná Nízke Tatry and the hotel Grand Jasná, Tri studničky and Ski Záhradky hotels in the Low Tatras.
